Dear Student,

For over 40 years, the Washington Metropolitan Area Chapters of the Order of AHEPA and the Daughters of Penelope have honored high school seniors affiliated with the AHEPA family or the Greek Orthodox Church who have achieved excellence in academic, athletic, civic, and cultural endeavors. Thus far, this Program has honored 1,452 students and awarded \$736,125 in scholarships. Last year, we honored 34 students and distributed \$33,600 in scholarships.

In order to be considered for an award, you must: (1) be affiliated with either the AHEPA family or the Greek Orthodox Church within the jurisdiction of the Greater Washington, D.C. Metropolitan Area; (2) be a graduating high school senior within the jurisdiction of the Greater Washington, D.C. Metropolitan Area; (3) have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 (a "B" average or better); and (4) have participated in extracurricular activities and/or lettered or received awards in varsity interscholastic sports. These scholarship awards are determined by an outside, independent panel of judges based on a competitive evaluation of the credentials presented. **Please read the application guidelines and checklist of requirements carefully to assist you in completing the application package**.

Students who meet the above requirements will be honored at this year's Awards Program on Sunday, May 15, 2011, at 2:00 p.m. at the Hilton Washington, DC/Rockville Hotel in Rockville, Maryland.

I encourage you to apply for this award. Your application packet **must be postmarked no later than** Saturday, April 2, 2011 and must be sent via FIRST CLASS Mail. It must include <u>three copies</u> of your completed application, your official transcript and ACT/SAT results, and a concise personal statement of approximately 100 words describing what you consider to be the most significant accomplishment(s) of your high school career. Your personal statement will also be used as the basis for your introduction at the Awards Program. Your application must also contain the required signatures which demonstrate your eligibility for an award. Please consult the checklist and guidelines on the reverse side of this letter to ensure that you have properly completed the application and provided all of the documentation required.

You will be notified of your eligibility by mail approximately three weeks after the April 2, 2011 deadline. Washington Metropolitan Area AHEPA Award Application Guidelines (2011)

This checklist is provided to assist you in completing the application. Please be as thorough and accurate as possible. We want to know all the things you have been involved in during your high school years.

Scholarship Program Qualifications (must meet all 3 requirements):

- □ I am a graduating high school senior from a high school within the Greater Washington, D.C. Metropolitan Area.
- \Box I have a cumulative grade point average of <u>3.0 ("B" average or better</u>), which is reflected on the official transcript submitted with this application.
- □ I am affiliated with *either* the AHEPA family *or* the Greek Orthodox Church within the Greater Washington, D.C. Metropolitan Area.

- □ **Part II Academic Information** Identify academic awards, honors, and special programs. Include copies of certificates of accomplishment documenting knowledge of the Greek language.

□ <u>*Three*</u> copies of SAT/ACT score results
